

Faith Credit options

As Catholics we are all about <u>faith and works</u>. Service has long been a part of the Confirmation process. As a way to enrich the *Catholic faith* experience of the candidates, they are required to have ten faith credits. It is recommended that the candidate experience a variety of faith enrichments. Here are suggested ways to fulfill this requirement.

Lenten Events

Stations of the Cross – 1 credit

Holy Thursday Mass & vigil afterward in Garden of Gethsemane- 2 credits

Good Friday services – 2 credits

Easter Vigil – 3 credits

Year Round Events – check the bulletin for dates and times

Eucharistic Adoration – 1 credit per hour spent

Holy Hour for Vocations – 2 credits first Thursday of the month at 7:00 p.m.

Healing Mass -1 credit second Wednesday of the month at 6:45 p.m.

Our Lady of Perpetual Help Devotions - 1 credit

Divine Mercy Chaplet – 1 credit

Catholic Funeral Liturgy – 1 credit

Attending one of the commission meetings for Family Life, Spiritual Life, Christian Service or Education Commission. These groups meet on the first Monday of the month at 7 p.m. in the Media Center— 1 credit per meeting

Attending any of the faith formation offerings at St. Robert such as speakers or other faith related talks. 1 credit per session
